






Kindergarten Age Requirements

Kinder Age Requirement

Students must turn 5 <u>on or</u> <u>before</u> <u>September 1.</u> <u>2023</u>

TK Age Requirement

Students turn 5 between September 2, 2023 thru April 2, 2024

Transitional Kindergarten (TK)

- Transitional Kindergarten is available to children turning 5 between September 2, 22-April 2, 2024
- If your child has an August birthday and you feel your child may benefit from an additional year before entering kindergarten, there may be room in the TK program.

- his or her preschool teacher recommended to wait a year.
- has had a serious illness that has delayed his or her development.
- your child is socially immature and/or unable to follow directions

Social Readiness

- have confidence to separate from parent.
- sit still and focus on an activity for 15 minutes.
- follow up to 3-step directions.
- finish a task within a given time.
- respect the rights and belongings of others.
- know how to share and take turns.
- can work individually and cooperatively in groups.















Verbal Readiness

- ask and answer questions appropriately.
- speak in complete sentences and is easily understood.














Kinesthetic Readiness

- hold a pencil with a the proper grip.
- cut with proper scissor grip.
- zip, button, and snap clothing.
- roll, throw, and catch a ball.
- run, hop, skip, jump, and swing.









Hygiene Readiness

- wash hands after using the restroom.
- cover mouth when coughing & sneezing.
- use tissues properly.
- attend to bathroom needs with independence and privacy.











Fine Motor Readiness

- correctly hold a pencil, crayon, and scissors.
- color without scribbling.
- write first name legibly.
- write some upper and lower case letters.
- copy numbers 1 10.











Academic Readiness

- Name colors and basic shapes.
- Count 10 objects and recognize numbers 1 through 10.
- Recognize most upper and lower case letters out of sequence.
- Know some letter sounds.










Math Series

 - Sit up straight








Kindergarten Manuscript Printing

- Three lines, dotted center line
- Finger space between words
- Good posture






